BENEATH THE CROWN unhurried during the opening stages, moved in tandem, from the three path, with CHINESE WHISPER past the early leaders midway on the second turn, engaged in a head to head duel with that rival, commencing from the five-sixteenths pole to the sixteenth marker, shook off that foe and proved best under a drive. CHINESE WHISPER (IRE) patiently handled, made a four wide sweep just to the outside of the top one to overpower the early pacesetters midway on the far turn, dug in while matching strides with the eventual winner until the sixteenth pole, grudgingly yielded at that point and had to settle for being second best. ALABAMA MAN prompted the pace from the outside, bumped with PRAIRIE BOY midway around the far turn while the top pair were scooting past them, tired steadily thereafter. HOT PACE placed under a firm hold while racing along the outside, was steadied to avoid the fallen foe on the far turn, had nothing to offer during the stretch run. TRIPLE HONOR failed to reach a contending position. PRAIRIE BOY set the pace along the inside, bumped with ALABAMA MAN while in tight quarters midway on the far turn, losing the rider in the process. There was a Stewards' inquiry focusing on the incident on the second turn before the result was declared official.
