WIN MILLIONS was unhurried, three path on the turns, lodged a bid and hung. PERRY LANE tracked off the rail, lacked room in nearing the eighth pole, checked, angled out and weakened. SECOND MORTGAGE five wide on the first turn, tracked the leader up the backstretch, four path on the last turn and weakened. HOT PACE set the pace along the four path on the first turn, three path on the final bend and tired. SIR JUSTIN reared and then lost the jockey in the starting gate. A stewards inquiry was posted concerning the start, resulted in no change.
