

7 FURLONGS. (Turf) (1.194) 3RD RUNNING OF THE NEW YORK STALLION CUPECOY'S JOY. Purse \$75,000 FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD ELIGIBLE FOR THE NEW YORK STALLION STAKES. By subscription of \$100 due on or before December 1, 2006, with the following eligibility payments: \$100 due on or before November 1, 2007; \$250 due on or before March 1, 2008; \$350 due on or before June 1, 2008. \$350 to pass the entry box, \$400 to start. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. 5% of purses won to be awarded to the Stallion nominator. 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstake on the turf or three races allowed 2 lbs.; two races or a race on the turf, 4 lbs.; a race, 6 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered in allowances). A maximum field of 12 horses will becarded. Preference to start will be determined by condition eligibility beginning with stake winners. Ties broken by total earnings. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at Seven Furlongs on the main track.). (Rail at 9 feet).

MOTHER RUSSIA broke sharply from the starting gate, worked her way over to the rail, remained on hold and along the inside until nearing the quarter pole, angled outward, responded when asked turning for home, took charge in the furlong grounds and edged away under active handling. WILD AWAKE outrun for a half, was taken to the outside of the course midstretch and finished with good energy. JET'S TRADITION was bumped at the start, was patiently handled down the backstretch, allowing ample opportunity for the iron-less rival to slip to the outside, continued biding her time from the two path until midway on the turn, advanced towards the leader when asked for run, kept the pressure on until the eighth pole, and held well to the wire. WON TOKEN raced three wide, loomed momentarily at the eighth pole, but failed to sustain her bid. WE'RE HOOKED lacked the necessary stretch response. HANNA CAN FLY was no factor. KITTYS WISH saved ground and outkicked weak rivals during the stretch drive. SEEK ON was no menace. JUDICIAL LEADER bumped at the start, was a pace factor along the inside until upper stretch and tired. NAVEDANO had the rider lose his irons soon after the start, ranged up between rivals to the front, was taken to the outside approaching the turn, remained forwardly placed until the quarter pole, then galloped to the wire.
