JET'S TRADITION set the pace under pressure along the rail for a half, opened a clear advantage in midstretch and held well under steady right hand urging. BIG BROWNIE broke a bit slowly, moved up quickly between horses, lodged a three wide bid on the turn and finished willingly to best the others. A SMART JUDGE pressed the winner from outside into midstretch and weakened. PETAL MEADOW raced between horses early, angled in on the turn and lacked a late response. WON TOKEN was under a firm hold in traffic early, steadied while lacking room at the half mile pole, angled in on the far turn and lacked a further response. SAARLANDISOURLAND raced four wide and tired. WORLD EXPRESS raced a bit greenly while failing to mount a serious rally. TRUST N INTUITION never reached contention after breaking a bit slowly.
